This job is primarily responsible for operating and maintaining grain handling, cleaning and storage systems. This is a general position that performs a wide variety of duties that are based on the daily needs of the operation.

Job Responsibilities

Actual responsibilities may vary based on daily needs of the facility.

- Fully participate in safe operation practices
- Perform critical operations to keep facility running
- Perform duties to load, unload and transfer grain to appropriate location.
- Perform duties required to maintain grain quality while being stored/transferred.
- Perform duties associated with the weighing of trucks and grading of grain.
- Perform general clean-up including sweeping, shoveling, washing, painting and other general housekeeping responsibilities.
- Operate, run, monitor and shut down dryer as required.
- Perform preventative maintenance and/or repairs.
- Operate a variety of heavy equipment including grain trucks on the road.
- Provide a high level of customer service by displaying courteous, helpful, knowledgeable interaction and behaviors.
- Be an involved/engaged member of a team and be willing to act and think independently.
- Complete documentation timely, accurately and legibly.
